Who can apply?

• Current AU students

What are the requirements?

For spring semester applicants:

Successful completion of BIO 160 with a final grade of B- or higher

For fall semester applicants:

- Successful completion of BIO 160 with a final grade of B- or higher AND
- Enrollment in or completion of (with a minimum grade of B- or higher) BIO 105 and CHE 102 by end of spring semester







Can I use my AP BIO credits from high school?

• Yes, if the credits have already been successfully accepted by AU, you do not need to take or be enrolled in BIO 160 (and lab) to apply

What if I haven't completed BIO 160, BIO 105, or CHE 102 and am not currently enrolled?

• You will need to work with your advisor during add/drop to enroll for these courses for the upcoming term/semester

- Nursing students also receive a minor in BIO.
- All nursing courses and their prerequisites require a benchmark grade of B- or higher.
- Nursing students must have at least a B- or above (2.7 GPA) to graduate.
- Nursing students graduate with 127 credits as opposed to the standard 120 credits.








How many change of major students will be accepted into the Froelich School of Nursing?

How do I apply?

- Submit letter of intent by Nov 5, 2021 by 4 pm (sp)
- Submit letter of intent by Mar 4, 2022 by 4 pm (fa)
- Download the Change of Major forms from: <u>https://www.assumption.edu/undergraduate/nursing</u>
- Follow the instructions
- Put some thought into your personal statement
- Compose a professional resume
- Reach out to faculty for letters of recommendations
- Submit all the proper documentation by the deadline and according to the instructions

• Applications

	Fall Semester 2 nd Year
4 pm on Dec 1st	4 pm on May 1st

- After final grades are posted
- Pre-determined weighted criteria in rank order

How will I find out if I'm offered a seat?

- Qualified applicants who are not accepted will remain on a waitlist in rank order
